VOTING

Using the voting facilities on the Forster Digital Photo competition gallery.

The web galleries provide a voting facility which is used to determine the "Voter's Choice" awards each month. Albums are opened for viewing, commenting and voting immediately after each monthly meeting. Voting remains open for two weeks following each meeting. The results of the Voter's Choice are emailed to members after voting closes and winning images are placed in the Winners Gallery on our web site. Prior to each meeting a list of all entries by title is emailed to members. A limited number of copies are also made available at each meeting. Members can use the list to note any images they may subsequently wish to vote for ... the list making it easier to locate particular images by using the search function provided in the gallery system.

To search for a particular image use the "Search" button which appears at the top of the gallery pages.



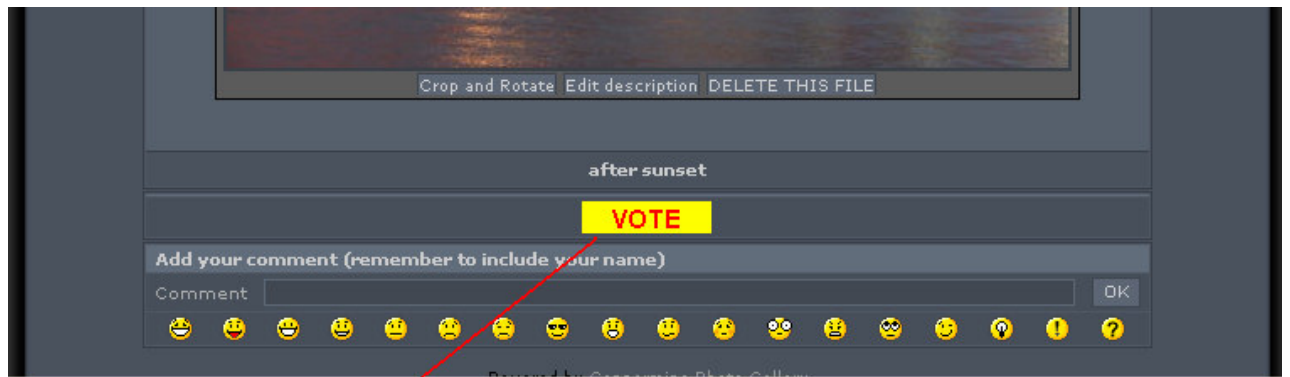
Use the search button to look for a particular image by title

You can enter any part of the image title in the search box. For example, typing the word beach in the box and clicking the "Search the file collection" button will find all images which have the word beach in the title ... such as "windy beach", "beach scene", "on the beach" etc.



Type the image title or part of the title into the search box

Once you have located the image you wish to vote for simply click the thumbnail to display the intermediate size image. Below the image you will see a "VOTE" button. All you need to do is click this button to register a vote for that image. After voting why not type in a comment? ... the comment box is just below the "VOTE" button.



Click the "VOTE" button to register your vote for the displayed image

Members can only vote for one image in each grade ... which means a total of eight votes, one in each grade in both open and set subject. Members can not vote more than once for any image and can not vote for their own images.
